Diane McElligott said there was a question from Mass River Alliance on a permit renewal regarding expansion and any planned dates for surface recharge. Diane said it has been answered. Lee said he did not believe that Chris Rositer was expecting any changes to the surface recharge; Chris stated that unless the plant were to see a drastic change in flows, he did not foresee changes in the future.

# 5) CDM Smith Annual Contract Approval Discussion:

6) Vote to Take by Eminent Domain certain land in the Town of Norton and to grant certain easements to the Town of Norton.

**Discussion**: Lee explained that the first document was drafted by Norton legal team and was reviewed by Joe Cove, MFN Counsel and himself; the second document was prepared by Joe Cove. Joe Cove stated an easement was added from the MFN to Norton, that the Town of Norton acknowledges forever that the MFN has an easement for the sewer and Norton must seek our approval for any construction on the easement line.

#### Motion:

That the MFN Regional Wastewater Commission, consistent with its intermunicipal agreement with the Town of Norton, enter into and direct its Executive Director to execute on behalf of the commission and under its seal the Joint Order of Taking with attached schedules "A" & "B" all in form as attached here with, and,

Further, that the MFN Regional Wastewater Commission execute in its name and under its seal acting through its Executive Director the easement deed with conditions recited therein all as in form attached here with and designated as "Grant of Easements". (Trowbridge/McElligott); all in favor; unanimous.

Lee stated that the signing of the vote needed to be done; that Mike Yunits needed to send the executed vote to MassDOT. Joe Cove said he believed as the MFN Executive Director, Lee could sign and file the document; that the MFN Executive Director is the keeper of the records. Josh Reinke, Mansfield Interim DPW Director inquired if Lee was going to record the vote, as Mansfield needed to record the Mansfield vote. Joe said it would need to be recorded and that the document was drafted as a certificate, and can be given to them to record with other documents.

### 7) Septage Rates

**Discussion**: A copy of the survey of the surrounding facility septage rates was provided prior to the MFN meeting. Lee said he and Chris Rositer reviewed the survey data and determined that MFN septage rates were near the top range of cost; he stated that they would recommend just rounding the numbers up to the whole digit. Diane McElligott stated that with Attleboro at only \$0.07/gallon and North Attleboro second at \$0.55/gallon, she was concerned due the lower rates, that the MFN facility may lose revenue to the other plants. Chris Rositer stated that it was possible, but that the increase was small enough and he didn't think it would affect the amount of septage being brought to the plant, as the haulers would need to use more gas to go to other plants.

Diane said she recalled at another meeting that the consensus was to keep rates as they are. Diane suggested to change the motion to read to leave the rates as they are and review in the spring; Mike Trowbridge said he agreed with Diane, that it may not be worth the small increase to lose the revenue if the haulers go to another plant.

To approve Septage Revenues go directly to the MFN Regional

Wastewater Direct.
